In checking our City owned canal land rentals, we find that another fifteen (15) years has elapsed on your canal land leases which makes rental adjustments possible, in accordance with provisions of our agreement.

The annual rentals on the two parcels leased by you have been as follows:-

Canal Lease No. 607	\$100.00 per year
Canal Lease No. 606	60.00 per year

The newly established rentals for these two parcels are as follows:-

Canal Lease No. 607	\$110.58 per year
Canal Lease No. 606	135.00 per year

The new rental figures are in accordance with Massillon's City Ordinance No. 29 which was passed on May 4, 1959.

Your voucher No. 42047 in the amount of \$ 80.00 eighty dollars for rental of city owned land, namely, Canal Leases Nos. 606-607, was received here April 28, 1960.

Attached please find copy of our letter dated March 16, 1960 to Pennsylvania Railroad Company, Cleveland, Ohio, in which we advised that the annual rentals for your two leases had been increased from \$ 160.00 to \$ 245.58 per year, the letter being self-explanatory.
