Said road being 25' in width and whose
center line is described as follows: Beginning
at a point on the east line of Cecil St. 76° 20' E
on an iron pin at the intersection of the east line of
Cecil St. and South line of an alley thence 50.48 to a P.C. of a 48° curve; thence along said curve to
the right 51.21 to the point of tangency; thence 51.45 E
91.83 to the P.C. of a 46° 30' curve; thence to the left
along said curve 66.67 to the point of tangency;
thence 582° 45' E 91.67 to the P.C. of an 18° curve;
thence along said curve to the left 54.81 to the point
of tangency; thence N 87° 23' E 90' more or less to
the west line of McClain Street.
