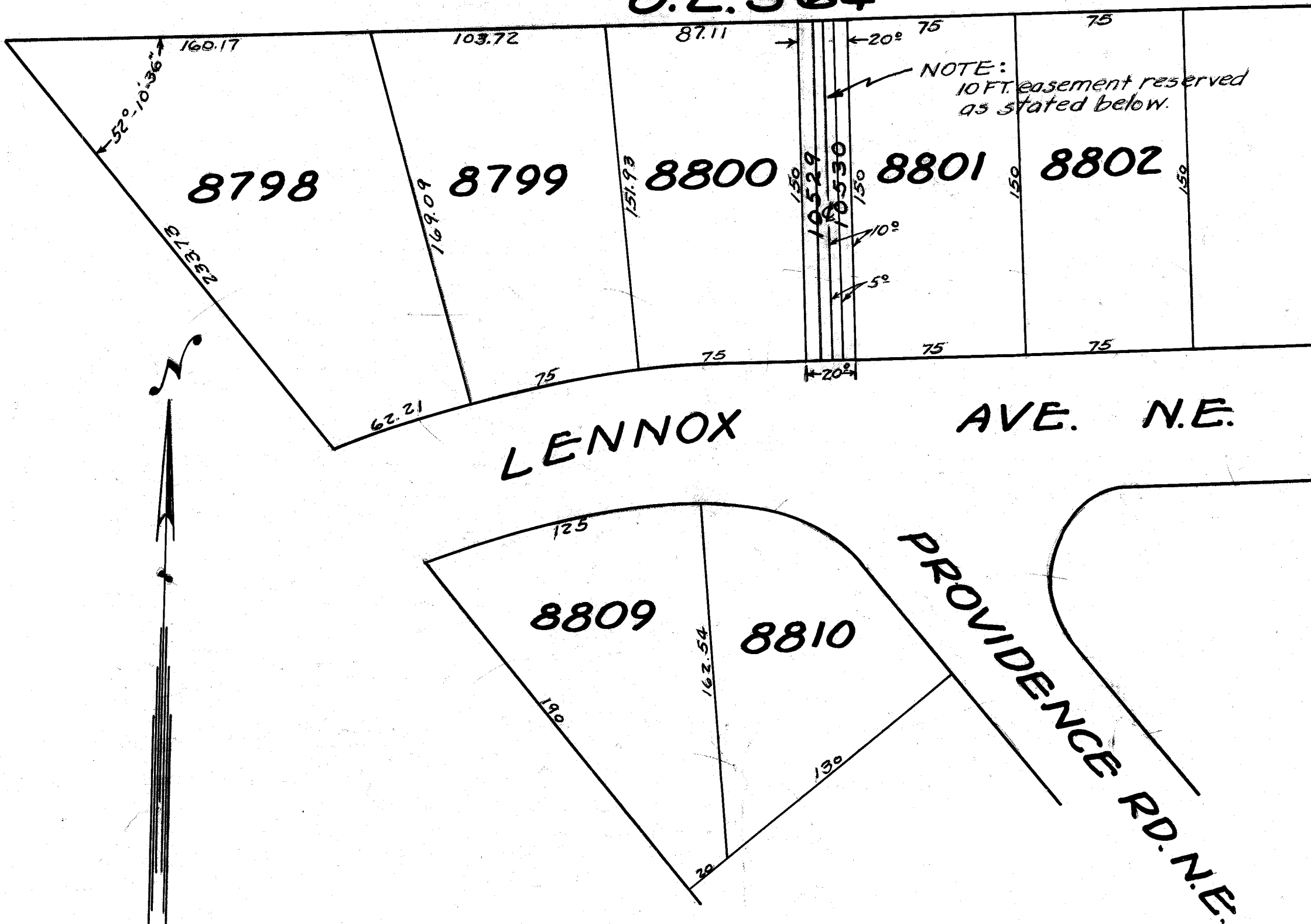

The above alley, between Lot No. 8800 and Lot No. 8801, running northerly from the North Line of Lennox Ave. N.E. 150 ft. to the South Line of O.L. 364, was vacated by the City Council of Massillon, Ohio by Ordinance No. 3532 passed March 18, 1940 except by terms of said ordinance: Reserving by said City the right to forever maintain the present existing storm sewer or rebuild same within a strip of land 10 ft. in width the length and on center line of said alley.
