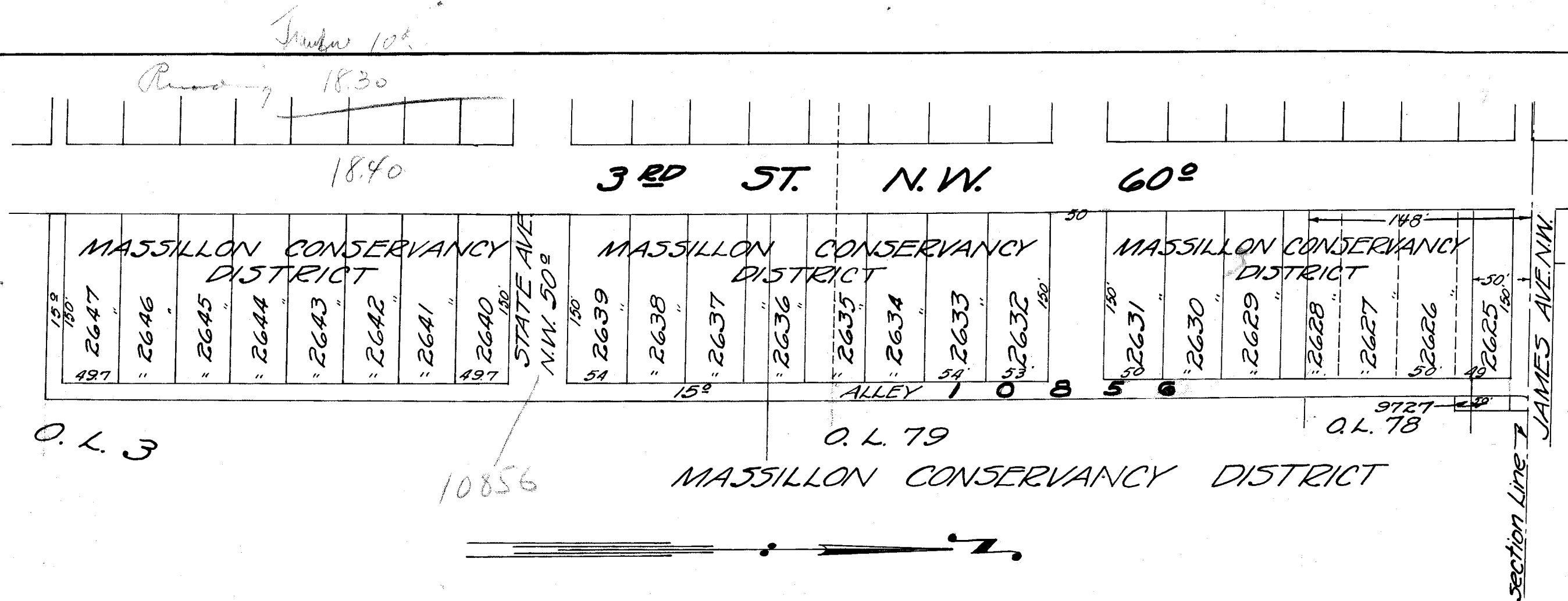

State Ave. N.W. - from east line of 3rd St. N.W. easterly 150 feet. Street between Lot No's 2631 and 2632 extending from the east line of 3rd St. N.W. 150 feet easterly.
