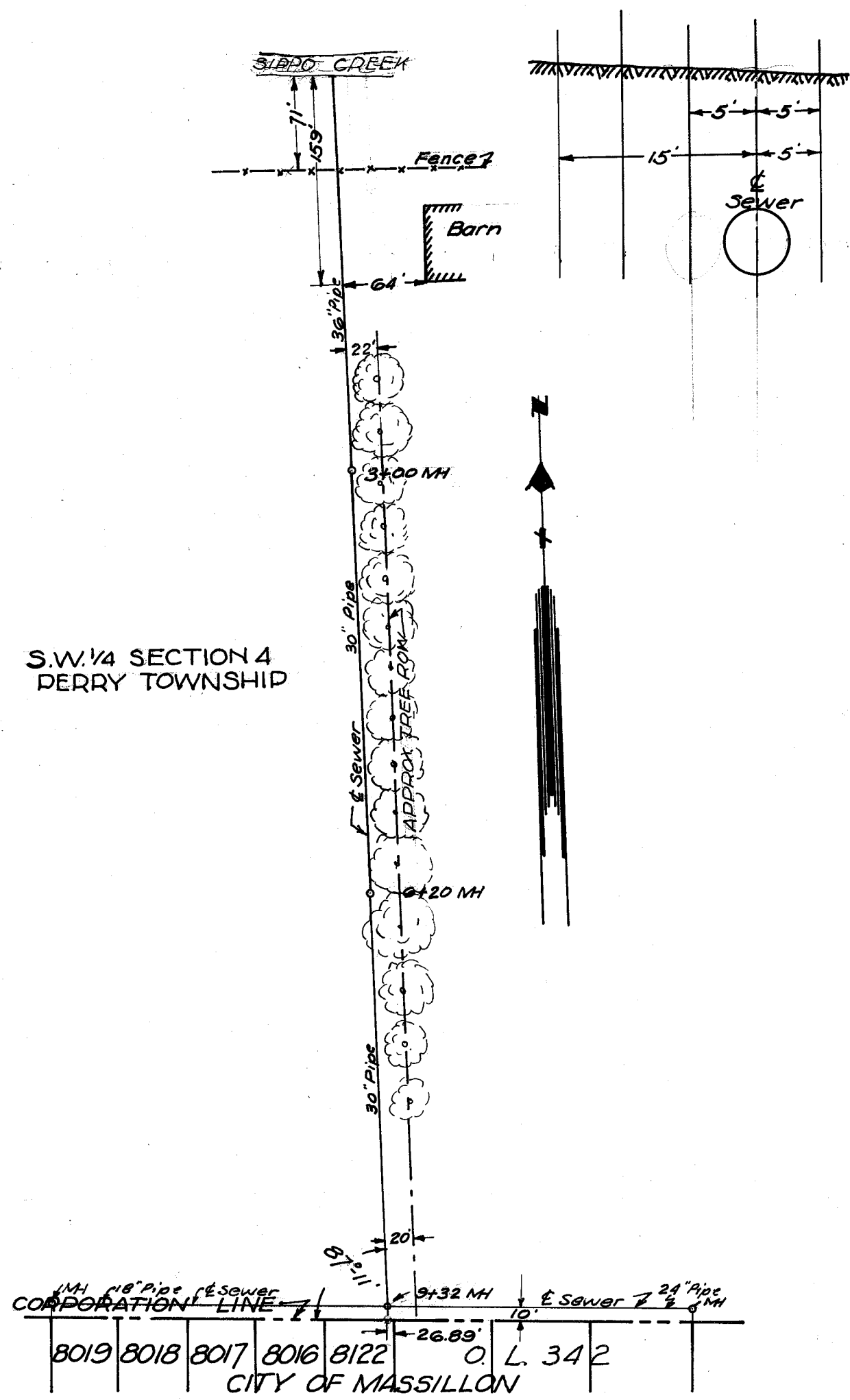




CERTIFICATION:

 We, the undersigned, owners of the land here-on shown, for the sum of \$200.00 and other considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant and convey to the City of Massillon, Ohio, and their successors, right to construct and forever maintain in and on said lands, a storm sewer of inside diameter as shown on this plat, with appurtenances situated within a strip of land 10 foot wide and with its centerline as shown here-on.
 Further that the City or its agents may have the temporary use for construction purposes of an additional strip of land 20 feet in width running parallel to the above sewer and situated with respect to said centerline as shown here-on.
