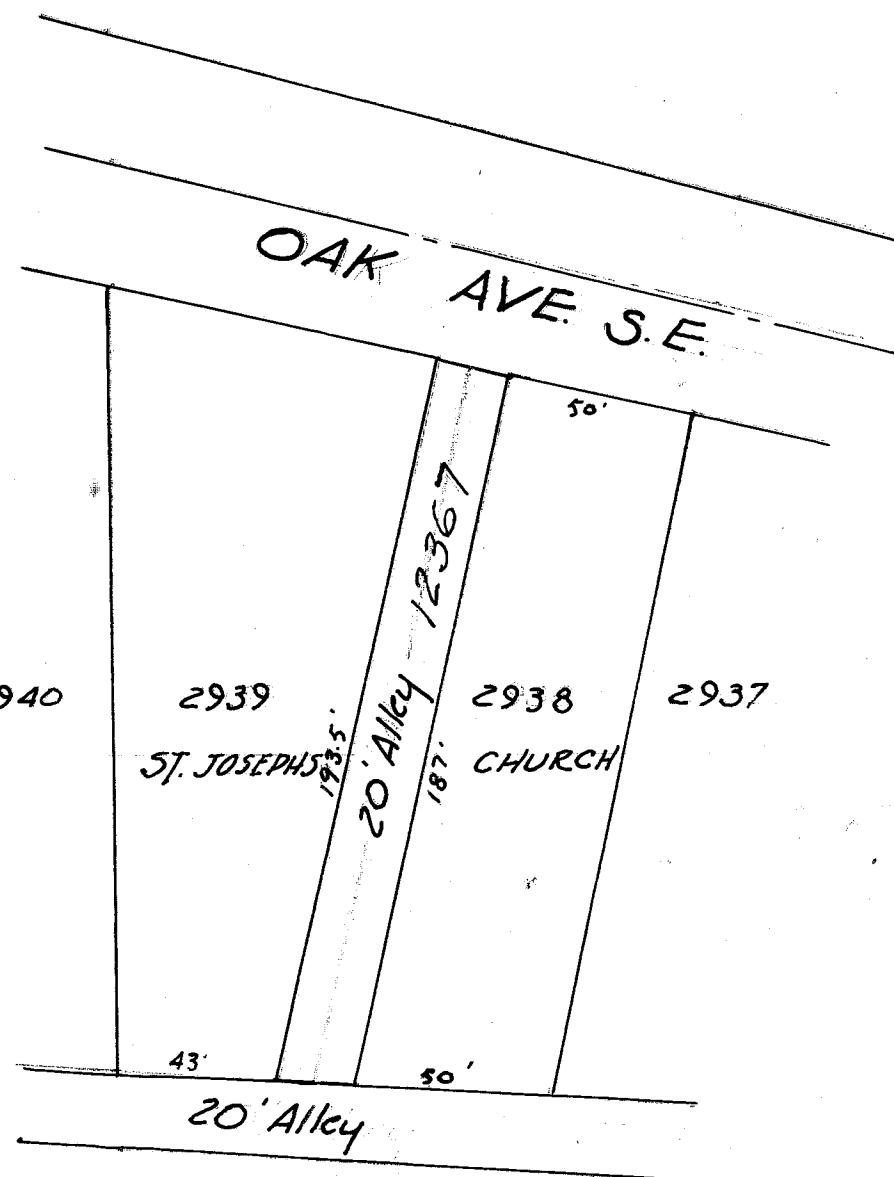




CERTIFICATION
