WHEREAS, the City owned property located at 610 Fourth Street S.W. is no longer needed for municipal purposes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Mayor and the Director of Public Service and Safety be and hereby are authorized to sign on behalf of the City of Massillon, Ohio, a Rental Agreement with Joetta Collins for certain property owned by the City of Massillon, Ohio, and described in Section 2.

Section 2:

That the Rental Agreement shall pertain to the following described property:

Residence located at 610 Fourth Street S.W. and also known as Lot No. 1875 in the City of Massillon.

Section 3:

That said premises shall be leased for an amount no less than Four Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$425.00) per month. Said Rental Agreement shall continue until November 15, 1997, and shall be renegotiated annually thereafter.

Section 4:

That Joetta Collins shall maintain the property and pay all utilities except sewer. A copy of said contract is hereby attached and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 5:

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the welfare and property of the community, such emergency arising out of the necessity to lease said real estate not presently needed for any municipal purpose. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RENTAL AGREEMENT

This **AGREEMENT** is the entire understanding between the City of Massillon referred to in this agreement as the LANDLORD, and Joetta Collins referred to in this agreement as the TENANTS, for rental of City owned residence at 610 Fourth Street SW, Massillon, Ohio 44647.

In consideration of the payment of the rent and performance of the terms set forth in this AGREEMENT, the City of Massillon, Ohio hereby rents to Joetta Collins the premises described in the AGREEMENT.

DWELLING - The dwelling which is the subject of this AGREEMENT is located at 610 Fourth Street SW, and is further described as Lot #1875 in the City of Massillon, Ohio

TERM & FEE - That said premises shall be leased for an amount of Four hundred twenty-five dollars (\$425.00) per month and is due on the 5th day of each month. Said Rental Agreement shall be in effect until November 15, 1997, and shall be renegotiated at that time. Any violation of any term will automatically cancel this agreement. A thirty (30) day notice is required by both parties to vacate the property.

USE BY TENTANT - Tenants shall use the dwelling solely as a residence for themselves. No pets or animals will be permitted on the property. Tenants shall not use the dwelling in an unlawful, unsafe, or noisy manner nor in any other manner which, in the sole opinion of the City of Massillon, shall constitute a nuisance. Failure to promptly abide by City of Massillon communicated decisions on all matters respecting use of premises shall constitute a breach of this AGREEMENT by Tenants.

REPAIRS - Joetta Collins shall maintain the property and pay all utilities. Joetta Collins shall be responsible for minor repairs and the City of Massillon shall be responsible for major repairs such as roof, furnace, etc. The Safety-Service Director shall determine major and minor repairs.

INSURANCE - Tenants are responsible for their household good and all their possessions, including automobile in case of loss or damage by any cause including fire or theft. Renter's insurance must be carried on said property. Tenant must provide City with a copy of insurance certificate.

ASSIGNMENT - This AGREEMENT may not be assigned or sublet by Tenants.

PARTIES - Where either the LANDLORD or TENANT are more than one person, this AGREEMENT applies to both persons jointly and each person separately.

Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
