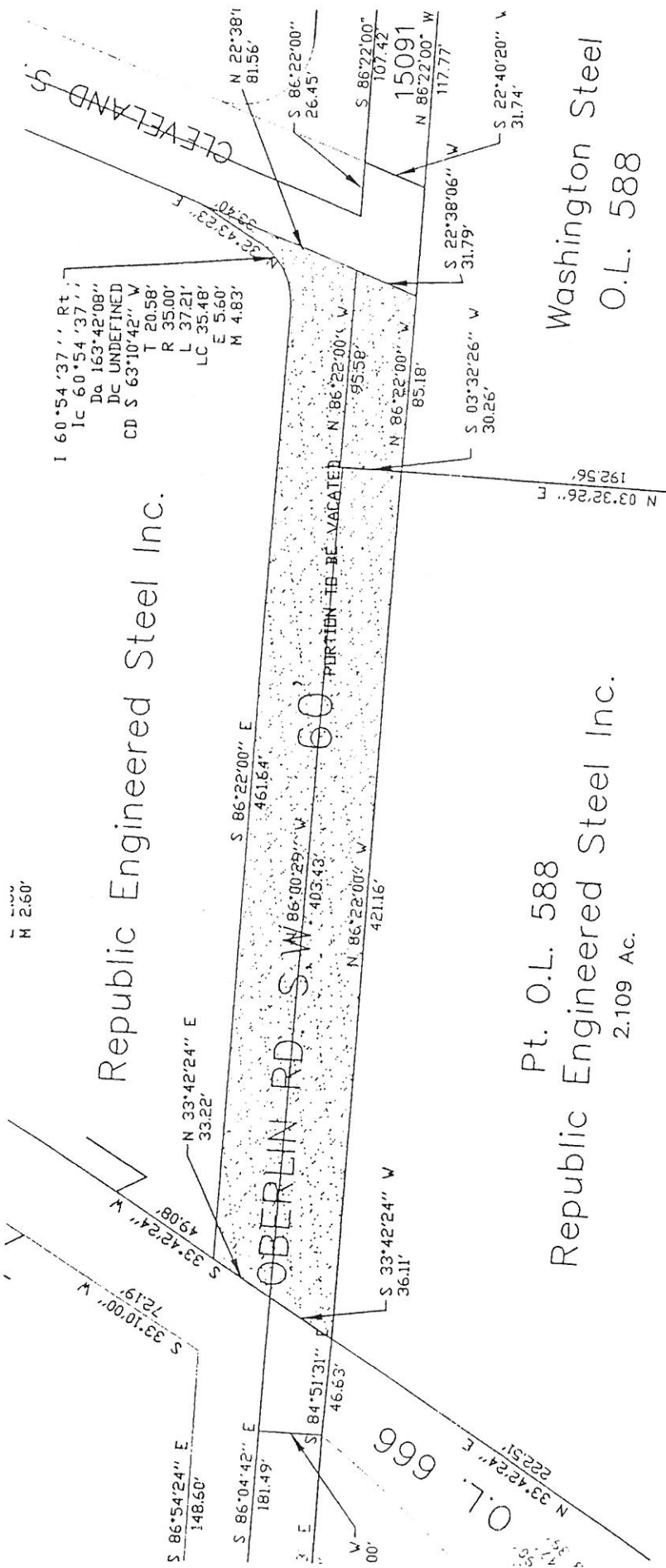

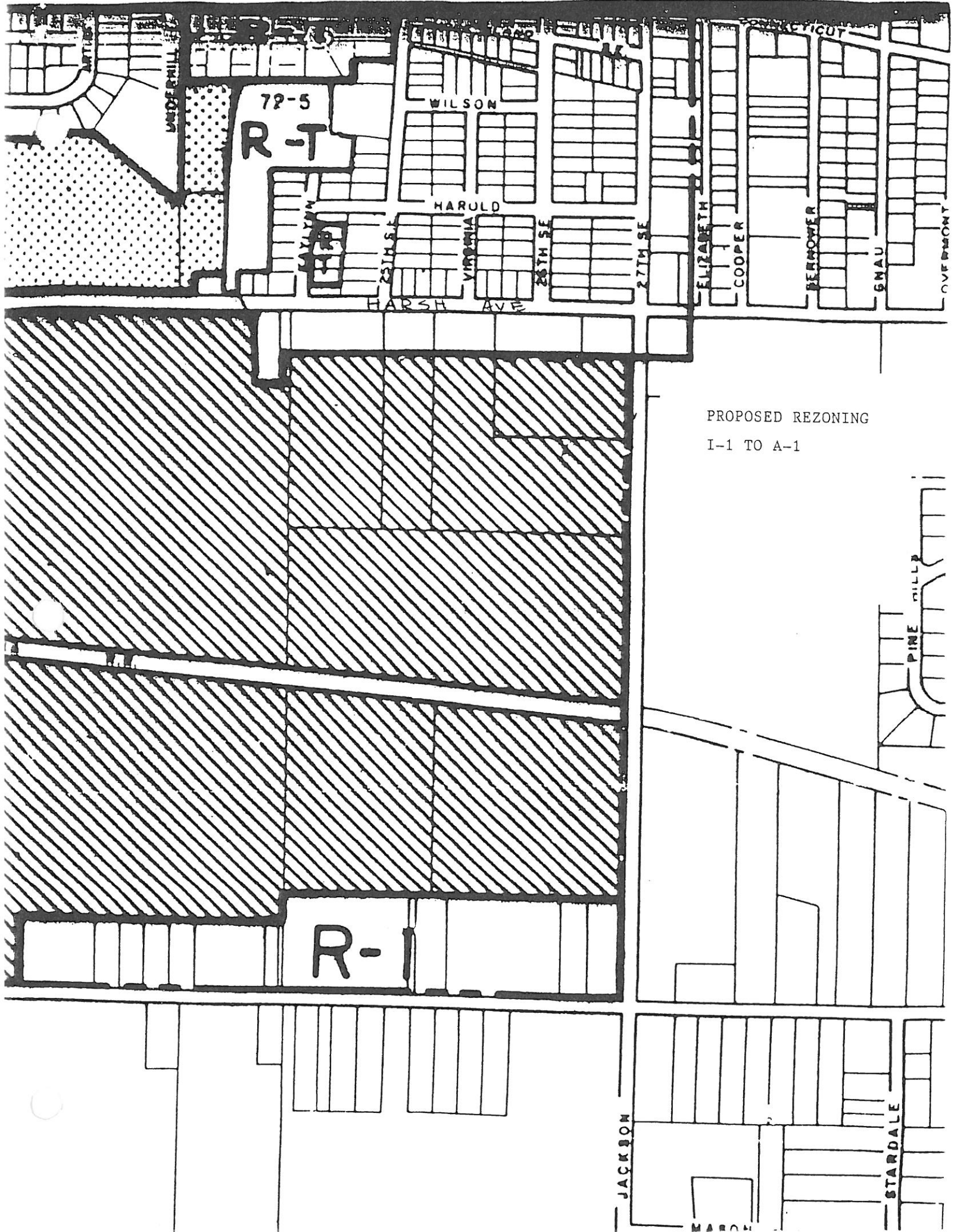

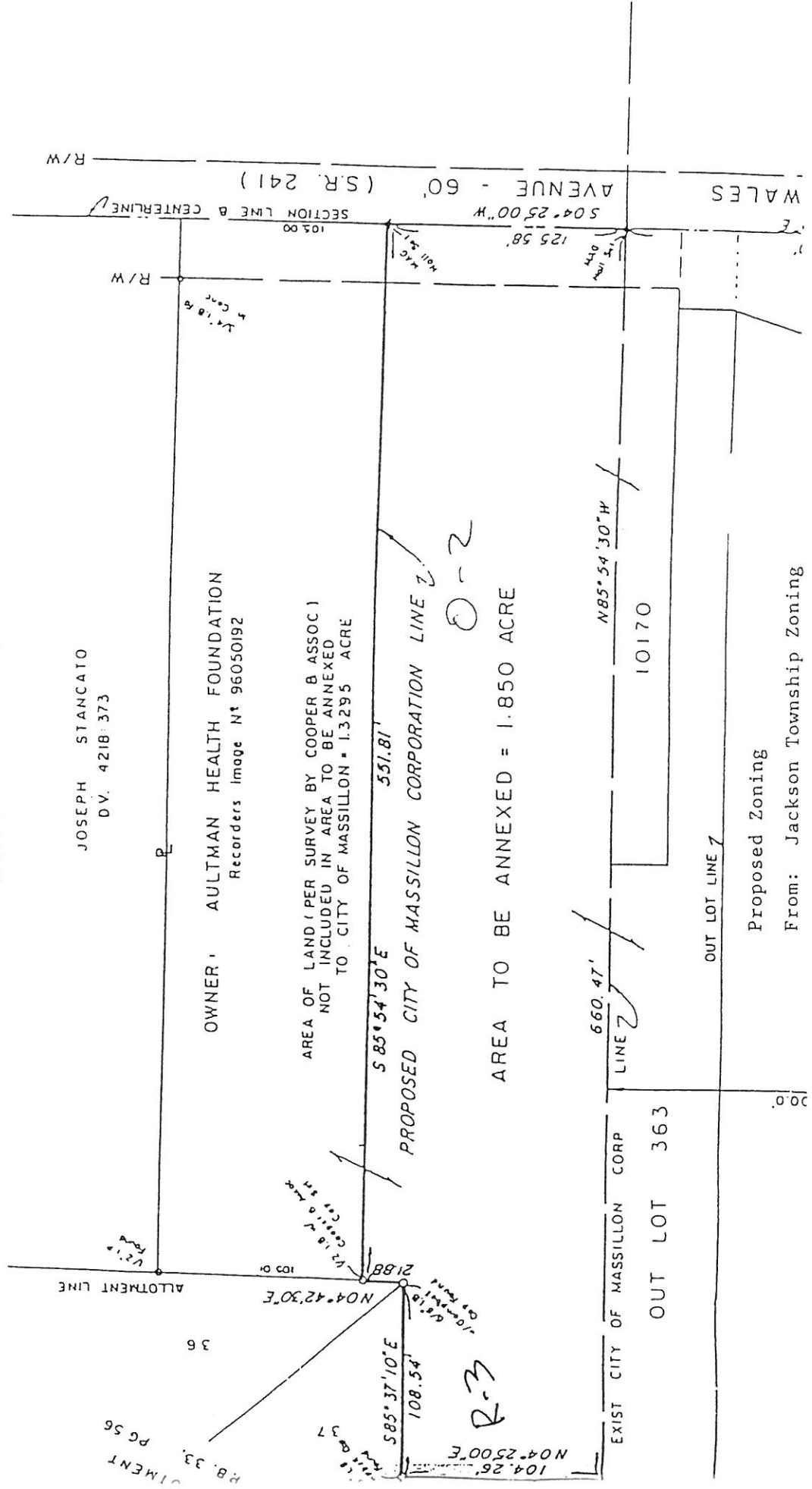

That this Resolution is declared an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary to implement a negotiated settlement of ongoing legal controversies concerning certain tracts of real property located in the Navarre Road-Fohl Road Area Annexation. Provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
