### Section 965.09

(j) Ninety-Two Percent (92%) of the amounts collected pursuant to the section shall be deposited into the Solid Waste Fund to be used for operating costs. Eight Percent (8%) shall be deposited into the Solid Waste Capital Improvement Fund to be used for improvements within the department.

### Section 3:

That the rates contained in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be effective on January 1, 1998 and thereafter.

### Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the reason for the emergency being that said provisions of existing Section 965.09 (j) have become cumbersome and difficult to audit and it is necessary to implement a new efficient formula for operating and capital improvement costs and for the additional reason for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.




