TITLE: AN ORDINANCE accepting an application for annexation for territory to the City of Massillon, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, a petition for the annexation for certain territory in Perry Township, was duly filed by Steven D. Hamit, Agent for the petitioners, and

WHEREAS, the said petition was duly considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Stark County on July 28, 1997, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on August 21, 1997, approved the annexation of said territory to the City of Massillon as hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified the transcript and pertinent documents of proceedings in connection with said annexation with the map and petition required in connection therewith, to the City Auditor of the City of Massillon, who received same on September 9, 1997, and

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the members elected to Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, have found, considered and determined that in order to annex said territory to the City of Massillon, this constitutes an emergency, requiring immediate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT

Section 1:
