The Director of Public Service and Safety is authorized to enter into an agreement to purchase the above described real estate for Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) and upon the execution and approval the said Director of Public Service and Safety he is further authorized to execute and approve all necessary documents to expedite the purchase of said real estate.

Section 3:

That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to pay the purchase price of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) from the Park and Recreation Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 4:

It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that the acquisition of the real estate is necessary for the construction of the community park by the year 1999.
