# Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder, for the purchase of One (1) EMS Unit for use in the Fire Department of the City of Massillon.

# Section 2:

That the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder, for the purchase of One (1) EMS Unit for use in the Fire Department of the City of Massillon.

# Section 3:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that the City prepare plans and specifications and advertise for and receive sealed bids for the purchase One (1) EMS Unit for use in the Fire Department. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
