Section 1:

There be and hereby is a reduced appropriation in the State Hospital Endowment Fund for the year ending December 31, 2002, the following:

Section 2:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that the appropriation needs to be reduced because of an audit finding.
