**ORDINANCE NO. 166 - 2003** 

BY: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE:

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE amending Section 1151.02 of the Massillon Code rezoning a 3.45 acre tract of land and establishing zoning for a certain tract of land recently annexed from Tuscarawas Township to Massillon City, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

#### Section I:

It is hereby determined to be in best interest and promotion of the general health, safety and provenience, comfort, prosperity and welfare of the community to change the designation of the area set forth in Section 2 hereof from R-2 One Family Residential (3.45 acres) and Tuscaraws Township - No Zoning (21.17 acres) to R-1 One Family Residential (3.45 acres), R-2 One Family Residential (16.98 acres) and R-T Two Family Residential (4.19 acres). Said rezoning was approved by the Planning Commission of the City of Massillon, Ohio, on October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2003 and that notice and public hearing has been given according to law.

## Section 2:


The City of Massillon, Ohio, Zone Map as identified by Section 1151.02 of the Massillon Code, be and is hereby amended as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto to show the following described area as R-1 One Family Residential (3.45 acres), R-2 One Family Residential (16.98 acres) and R-T Two Family Residential (4.19 acres):

Being known as Out Lots No. 614, 916, 917, 918, 919, 920 and 921, a 24.62 acre parcel of land located on the west side of 32<sup>nd</sup> Street N.W., north of Bonnie Brae Drive. A portion of this site was recently annexed to the City from Tuscarawas Township. The residential allotment will be known as Woodland Creek.

## Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure in that the use herein provided for is essential to the proper community growth and hence immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and that this property would best be served to be designated R-1 One Family Residential, R-2 One Family Residential and R-T Two Family Residential. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

## Section I:

# PETITION BY CITIZENS FOR THE ROHR STORAGE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF MASSILLON, OHIO

#### TO THE COMMISSIONERS OF STARK COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

We, the undersigned, being a majority of the adult owners of real estate in the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition for the annexation of the following described territory to the City of Massillon, Massillon Township, Stark County, Ohio.

Situated in the Township of Tuscarawas, County of Stark and State of Ohio: Situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 12-N, Range 10-W, Tuscarawas Township, Stark County, Ohio and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron bar known as the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, said bar also being on the centerline of Kenyon Avenue (Township Road 340) a 30.00 foot public right of way,

Thence N 5°00'00"E along the section line and with the centerline of Kenyon Avenue a record distance of 1228.70 feet to a point where the centerline of Lincoln Highway intersects the section line,
