ORDINANCE NO. 57 - 2005

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the Lincoln Center Phase III Infrastructure Improvement Fund, 16th Street Project Fund, Summer Concert Fund, Capital Improvement Fund and the General Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Lincoln Center Phase III Infrastructure Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, the following:

\$1,726,558.26 to an account entitled "Lincoln Center Phase III Project" 1483.425.2510

Section 2:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 16th Street Project Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, the following:

Section 3:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Summer Concert Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, the following:

\$20,075.00 to an account entitled "Services/Contracts" 1212.505.2392

Section 4:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, the following:

\$3,494.00 to an account entitled "Fire Department Equipment" 1401.325.2531

Section 5:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2005, the following:

\$100.00 to an account entitled "Supplies/Materials/Postage" 1100.325.2410

Section 6:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 7 - 2005

BY COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

TITLE: A RESOLUTION in support of protecting Social Security for *All Americans* ~~Steelworkers~~ #1124

WHEREAS, since 1934 Social Security has provided working Americans and their families a basic protection against "growing old without the means of support."

WHEREAS, for many retired Americans and future retirees, Social Security will provide a significant, and in most cases, a majority share of their income. In addition, Social Security provides and will provide for many disabled Americans and widows and children of many who tragically died young, the benefits to keep their families out of poverty.

WHEREAS, Privatization of Social Security will diminish the guaranteed benefits of the millions who will come to rely on the Social Security system in the future and drain from the Social Security trust funds billions of dollars while adding to the federal deficit by trillions of dollars.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we the Members of the Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, do hereby publicly urge Congress to pursue bi-partisan efforts that will guarantee full benefits for all deserving Americans, to oppose all privatization efforts which could threaten the system's future and use all reasonable means to secure the future solvency of the Social Security System.
