NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

#### Section I:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public realth, safety and welfare to advertise for and receive sealed bids, according to law, and to enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder, for the removal and sale of specified trees at the Legends Golf Course in the City of Massillon.

# Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and to receive sealed bids according to law, and enter into contract upon award and approval by the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for the removal and sale of specified trees at the Legends Golf Course in the City of Massillon.
