ORDINANCE NO. 124 - 2007

BY: HEALTH, WELFARE AND BUILDING REGULATIONS COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE amending CHAPTER 1309 "HOUSING CODE" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon, Ohio, by repealing existing Section 1309.14(a) "REPAIR, REMOVAL OR SECURING OF FIRE DAMAGED BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES" and enacting a new Section 1309.14(a) "REPAIR, REMOVAL OR SECURING OF FIRE DAMAGED BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES" of CHAPTER 1309, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

The existing Section 1309.14(a) "REPAIR, REMOVAL OR SECURING OF FIRE DAMAGE BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES" of CHAPTER 1309 "HOUSING CODE" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon, Ohio, be and hereby is repealed.

Section 2:

That there be and hereby is enacted a new Section 1309.14(a) "REPAIR, REMOVAL OR SECURING OF FIRE DAMAGE BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES" of CHAPTER 1309 "HOUSING CODE" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon, Ohio, be and hereby is enacted. Said amendment is indicated in bold type on the attached exhibit "A".

Section 3:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and for the further reason that the building department would be in compliance with ORC 715.26(f). Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

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1309.14 REPAIR, REMOVAL OR SECURING OF FIRE DAMAGED BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES.

when the loss agreed to between the named insured or insureds and the insurance company or insurance companies equals or exceeds sixty percent (60%) of the aggregate limits of liability on all fire policies covering the building or structure, the insurance company or companies in accordance with Ohio R.C. 715.26(f) shall transfer from the insurance proceeds to the City Auditor in the aggregate amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000) for each fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) and each fraction of that amount, of a claim, or, if at the time of a proof of loss agreed to between the named insured or insureds and the insurance company or companies the named insured or insureds have submitted a contractor's signed estimate of the costs of removing, repairing, or securing the building or other structure, shall transfer from the insurance proceeds the amount specified in the estimate. There shall be a minimum transfer of one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
