NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to enter into an agreement with the Board of Stark County Commissioners, upon approval of the Board of Control, for the purchase of salt for ice control on city streets.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with the Board of Stark County Commissioners, upon approval of the Board of Control, for the purchase of salt for ice control on city streets.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, participating in the cooperative purchase program saves the city money in its salt purchases and for the additional reason for the more efficient operation of the Street Department in the City of Massillon during the winter months. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to submit an application for Ohio Public Works Commission Funding for the 2009 funding year, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary and in the public health, safety and welfare to authorize the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to submit an application for Ohio Public Works Commission Funding for the 2009 funding year and execute any such documents necessary to obtain such funding.

Section 2:

That the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for the 2009 Ohio Public Works Commission Funding and execute any documents necessary to obtain such funding for the following projects for the year 2009. Said projects shall be as follows:

- A. 32nd Street SW Bridge Replacement
- B. Bar Screen Replacement WWTP
- C. NEOCOM Sanitary Trunk Sewer Extension

Section 3:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary to submit the application in order to receive Ohio Public Works Funding. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
