TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, Wastewater Treatment Fund, 16<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvement Fund and the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2008, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2008, the following:

\$104,906.00 to an account entitled "Police Cruiser Payment" 1401.905.2530  
\$ 51,500.00 to an account entitled "Fire Truck Lease Payment" 1401.325.2530  
\$ 19,780.00 to an account entitled "Street Sweeper Lease Payment" 1401.435.2530

Section 2:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Wastewater Treatment Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2008, the following:

\$48,000.00 to an account entitled "Services/Contracts" 2101.610.2392  
\$14,600.00 to an account entitled "Sanitary Manhole/Sewer Repairs" 2101.610.2516

Section 3:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 16<sup>th</sup> Street Intersection Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2008, the following:

\$50,000.00 to an account entitled "Intersection Design Projects" 1410.435.2511

Section 4:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Law Enforcement Trust Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2008, the following:

\$10,000.00 to an account entitled "New Equipment" 1215.305.2530

Section 5:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
