ORDINANCE NO. 71 - 2009

BY: POLICE AND FIRE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury, for the purchase of six (6) police cruisers for the Massillon Police Department, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury, for the purchase of six (6) police cruisers for the Massillon Police Department. The cost of said contract shall not exceed One Hundred Fifty-Eight Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (158,325.00)

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury, for purchase of six (6) police cruisers for the Massillon Police Department.

Section 3:

Upon delivery of the aforesaid agreement, the Director of Public Service and Safety is hereby authorized to issue vouchers to the Auditor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, directing prompt payment for said agreement and the City Auditor is authorized and directed to honor and pay said vouchers.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason the City of Massillon enter into a contract with Statewide Ford Lincoln Mercury, so the six (6) police cruisers may be purchased for use by the Police Department. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO.72 – 2009

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2009, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2009, the following:

\$56,349.00 to an account entitled "lease/purchase police cruisers" 1401.305.2530

Section 2:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
