ORDINANCE NO. 130 - 2009

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign all applicable loan documents with the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental & Financial Assistance (DEFA) for the NEOCOM Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary to sign all applicable loan documents with the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental & Financial Assistance (DEFA) for the NEOCOM Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project.

Section 2:

The Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized to sign all applicable loan documents with the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental & Financial Assistance (DEFA) for the NEOCOM Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project. The City of Massillon has received 50% of the project costs through the America Reinvestment and Recovery Act. The remainder project costs will be funded through the Wastewater Treatment Plant Capital Improvement Fund which is already in place.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and for the reason that it is necessary for these loan documents to signed in a timely manner since time is of the essence. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
