ORDINANCE NO. 84 - 2009

BY: ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder, upon the approval of the Board of Control for the Neocom Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder, upon the approval of the Board of Control for the Neocom Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and receive sealed bids according to law, with the lowest and best bidder and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder, upon the approval of the Board of Control for the Neocom Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project. The estimated cost is \$191,209.00. The city will be receiving \$95,000.00 in stimulus money to apply to this project with remaining monies coming from the Wastewater Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that bids be received so that work may be timely commenced on the Neocom Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Project. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


