NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

#### Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to enter into a contract with Wheeled Coach Industries, Inc., for the purchase of a 2009 Ford E450 XL Wheeled Coach Type III Ambulance for the Massillon Fire Department.

#### Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Wheeled Coach Industries, Inc., for purchase of a 2009 Ford E450 XL Wheeled Coach Type III Ambulance for the Massillon Fire Department. The cost of the ambulance will be One Hundred Four Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars (\$104,995.00). These funds will come from the Capital Improvement Fund.

#### Section 3:

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason for the efficient operation of the Massillon Fire Department. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION NO. 2 - 2010

BY: COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE

TITLE: A RESOLUTION to fully fund retiree pensions held by the P.B.G.C. investigate misuse of pension funds.

WHEREAS, the United States Steel Workers have been the back bone of industry in the Midwest; and

WHEREAS, over the last 30 years the steel industry has fallen on hard times; and

WHEREAS, the steel workers union has sacrificed wages and other benefits to insure their retirement benefits were met; and

WHEREAS, countless steel workers have retired and taken early retirement to save the benefits they have accrued; and

WHEREAS, the steel workers have negotiated and were promised a secure self sustaining retirement fund; and

WHEREAS, some retirement benefits have been paid at less than negotiated rates; and

WHEREAS, some retirees have had their benefits cut over the last few years; and

WHEREAS, there seems to be a sense of urgency concerning the health of the retirement funds; and

WHEREAS, the GOA is currently getting pressure from the United States Senator Sherrod Brown's office and Congressman Dennis J. Kucinch, S.O.A.R. Executive Board of Stark County and others to audit the Pension Guarantee Corporation to make sure the fund is healthy and all benefits are being paid at the negotiated rate; and

Now, therefore be it resolved that Massillon City Council hereby go on public record requesting and supporting a full audit of the Government run Pension Guarantee Corporation.
