TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the SR 241 Paving Project, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the SR 241 Paving Project.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the SR 241 Paving Project. The project funding will be 80/20 with ODOT being responsible for 80% and the City 20% of all project cost unless the city requests items for the project deemed unnecessary by the State and Federal Highway Administration.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and for the reason that it is necessary to sign the Preliminary Legislation with Ohio Department of Transportation so as to proceed with the SR 241 Paving Project. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
