## Section 1:

The City of Massillon has been award a Three Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$300,000) grant through the Clean Ohio Assistance Fund which will be used for the study.

## Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and for the reason that the signing of the Participation and Redevelopment Agreement is necessary for the performance of the Phase II Environmental Assessment for the former Republic Steel Property. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
