ORDINANCE NO. 102 - 2011

BY: STREETS, HIGHWAYS, TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for various street improvements in the City of Massillon, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for various street improvements in the City of Massillon.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and receive sealed bids according to law, and to enter into contract upon award and approval by the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for various street improvements in the City of Massillon. Estimated project cost is One Hundred Nine Thousand Dollars (\$109,000.00) which will be funded by the 1401 Capital Improvement Fund, 1401.435.2510 Fifty-Eight Thousand Dollars (\$58,000.00) Street Resurfacing and 1206 Municipal Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund 1206.435.2510 Street Repair Fifty-One Thousand Dollars (\$51,000.00). Full depth pavement replacement will be completed on deteriorated roadways located on the following streets:

- A). Lanedale Street NW
- B). Woodstone Avenue NW
- C). Augusta Drive SE
- D). Veterans Boulevard SE
- E). Cyprus Drive SE

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that bids be received so that work may be completed on these various street improvements projects. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
