ORDINANCE NO. 80 - 2011

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to enter into a contract upon approval of the Board of Control with CTI Engineers, Inc., for the Construction Administration Services for the Bar Screen & Grit Screw Replacement Project at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

## Section I:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to enter into a contract upon approval of the Board of Control with CTI Engineers, Inc., for the Construction Administration Services for the Bar Screen & Grit Screw Replacement Project at the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

## Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract upon approval of the Board of Control with CTI Engineers, Inc., for the Construction Administration Services for the Bar Screen & Grit Screw Replacement Project at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The cost of said project is not to exceed Eighteen Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$18,200.00). Funds to pay the City's portion of the services will be provided for from the 1406 WWT Capital Improvement Fund. Workman Industrial Services, Inc., from Kent, Ohio is the contractor for said project with a contract price of Four Hundred Nineteen Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Four Dollars (\$419,724.00). The cost for these services will be split equally with Stark County.

## Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that the agreement is signed so the Bar Screen & Grit Screw Replacement Project may begin in a timely manner. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
