ORDINANCE NO.90 – 2011

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the 1410 16th Street Project Fund, General Fund, 1206 Muni Motor Vehicle Fund and the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2011, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1410 16th Street Project Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2011 the following:

\$49,875.00 to an account entitled "Contracted Services" 1410.435.2392

Section 2:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the General Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2011 the following:

\$15,000.00 to an account entitled "Land Acquisitions" 1100.905.2510

Section 3:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1206 Muni Motor Vehicle Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2011 the following:

\$5,000.00 to an account entitled "Gas & Oil" 1206.435.2430

\$3,000.00 to an account entitled "Street Repair" 1206.435.2510

Section 4:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2011 the following:

\$1,000.00 to an account entitled "Income Tax Copier" 1401.210.2530

Section 5:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
