ORDINANCE NO. 93 - 2012

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the 1410 16<sup>th</sup> Street Project Fund, 2105 Stormwater Utility Fund and the 1482 OPWC Project Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2012, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1410 16<sup>th</sup> Street Project Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2012 the following:

\$44,040.70 to an account entitled "1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project" 1410.435.2513

Section 2:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 2105 Stormwater Utility Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2012 the following:

\$64,380.34 to an account entitled "1<sup>ST</sup> Street NE Improvement Project" 2105.435.2510

Section 3:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1482 OPWC Project Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2012 the following:

\$433,684.14 to an account entitled "1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project" 1482.435.2515

Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
