ORDINANCE NO. 60 - 2012

BY: STREETS, HIGHWAYS, TRAFFIC & SAFETY COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to advertise for, receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for the 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project in the City of Massillon, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to advertise for, receive sealed bids and enter into a contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for the 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project in the City of Massillon.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for, receive sealed bids according to law, and to enter into contract upon award and approval by the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for the 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project in the City of Massillon. Project limits along 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE are Cherry Road NE to Lake Avenue NE with Main project components consisting of items such as partial and full depth pavement repair; grinding of existing asphalt surface; 2' 448 Asphalt Concrete Surface Course, Curb Ramp Installation; Catch Basin Replacement; Storm Sewer Piping Replacement; Sanitary Sewer Piping Replacement; Manholes Casting Replacement; Pavement Markings. The project estimate is Eight Hundred One Thousand One Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$801,173.00). The City has received a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for this project and at this time the City cost share for the project is projected to be One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00)

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that bids be received so that work may be completed on the 1<sup>st</sup> Street NE Improvement Project. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
