TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to submit an application for funding to Ohio EPA's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) and execute any necessary documents for upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

## Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for funding to Ohio EPA's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) and execute any necessary documents for upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

## Section 2:

The Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for funding to Ohio EPA's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) and execute any necessary documents for upgrade to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. The proposed upgrades to be completed are based on the Facility Plan Update that was completed by CTI Engineers, Inc., which incorporated the Ohio EPA's requirements to the City's NPDES Permit for the WWTP Facility and for future capacity needs. The current preliminary construction estimate is Twenty-Three Million Six Hundred Forty-One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars (\$23,641,956.00) for which Stark County will fund approximately Fifty percent (50%) of the project.

## Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and for the additional reason that it is necessary to submit the application for funding for the necessary upgrades to the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
