ORDINANCE NO. 11 - 2013

BY: ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE:

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE amending CHAPTER 1185 "FLOOD PLAIN AREAS" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon, Ohio, by repealing existing Section 1185.09(a) "Designation of the Floodplain Administrator" and enacting replacement Section 1185.09(a) "Designation of Floodplain Administrator", and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

The existing Section 1185.09(a) "Designation of the Floodplain Administrator" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon is hereby repealed.

Section 2:

That there hereby is enacted new Section 1185.09(a) "Designation of the Floodplain Administrator" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon. Said newly enacted Section shall read as follows:

1185.09(a) <u>Designation of the Floodplain Administrator</u>: The City Engineer is hereby appointed to administer and implement these regulations and is referred to herein as the Floodplain Administrator.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community, and for the further reason that this change is simply a language change from Chief Building Official to City Engineer. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE amending Ordinance No. 3 – 2010 and all other ordinances inconsistent therewith by repealing Section 8, paragraphs (f)(1) and (f)(6), and enacting new Section 8, paragraphs (f)(1) and (f)(6), and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

Ordinance No. 3-2010 by deleting paragraphs (f)(1) and (f)(6) of existing Section 8, paragraph (f) and replacing them with the following new amended sections

<u>Section 1</u>: The City of Massillon will provide health care insurance to eligible city employees who elect to participate in the health care insurance as outlined in the Health Care Committee By-Laws per Ordinance No. 151 – 2012.

Sections (2)(3)(4)(5)(7) and (8) remain the same.

Section 6: All new employees who meet the eligibility requirements as established may elect to enroll in said insurance program on the 1st day of the month following the date of hire. Eligible employees not participating in the health insurance may elect to participate during open enrollment or in the event of a qualifying event.

Section 2:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 3:

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the reason for the emergency being that said amendment is necessary to omit the waiting period for newly hired employees to be covered under the City's health insurance. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Law of the City of Massillon, to renew the one year contract with the City of Canal Fulton, for the purpose of providing prosecutorial services, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary for the Director of Law of the City of Massillon, to renew the one year contract with the City of Canal Fulton for the purpose of providing prosecutorial services.

Section 2:

The Director of Law of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized to renew the one year contract with the City of Canal Fulton for the purpose of providing prosecutorial services. The City of Canal Fulton shall pay the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$25,200.00) under the terms of the contract. The contract will be from February 1, 2013 through January 31, 2014. These funds will go into the General Fund.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and for the additional reason the City of Canal Fulton has requested the Director of Law of the City of Massillon to prosecute all criminal and traffic cases that come before the Massillon Municipal Court and it is necessary to be effective immediately so that increased revenue can be received. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
