That the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for the 2014 Ohio Public Works Commission Funding and execute any documents necessary to obtain such funding for the following project for the year 2014. Said project shall be as follows:

- a). Hankins Road NE Improvement Project
- b). 9th Street SW Improvement Project

# Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

#### Section 4:

That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary to submit the project in order to receive Ohio Public Works Funding for the 2014 funding year. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
