ORDINANCE NO. 38 - 2013

BY: ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into contract, upon award and approval of the Board of Control, with the lowest and best bidder for the Levee Infrastructure Improvement Project, and declaring an emergency..

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section I:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to advertise for and receive sealed bids and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder for the Levee Infrastructure Improvement Project.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for and receive sealed bids according to law, and enter into contract with the lowest and best bidder for the Levee Infrastructure Improvement Project. The total estimated project cost is One Million Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Improvement Project. The total estimated project cost is One Million Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Industrial Three Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars (\$1,733,389.00) with a funding breakdown of 30% local funds, 70% OPWC funds. The City's share will be paid from the 1414 Collection System Improvement Fund and the 2105 Stormwater Utility Fund.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary that bids be received so that work may be timely commenced on the Levee Infrastructure Improvement Project. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
