ORDINANCE NO. 123 – 2014

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the 1206 Municipal Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund and making certain appropriations from the unappropriated balance of the 1401 Income Tax Capital Improvement Fund for the year ending December 31, 2014, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1206 Municipal Motor Vehicle License Plate Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2014, to the following:

\$ 49,000.00 to an account entitled "Street Repair" 1206.435.5.2510

Section 2:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1401 Income Tax Capital Improvement Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2014, to the following:

\$ 2,000.00 to an account entitled "Police Cruisers" 1401.305.2530

These funds will be used to pay for painting decaling two (2) cruisers; one purchased from Jackson Township and the other a seized vehicle.

Section 4:


The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 5:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


