**ORDINANCE NO. 126 – 2014**

BY: STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to change the speed limit within the corporation limits of the City of Massillon on Southway Street, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon hereby determines it to be necessary to authorize the director of Public Service and Safety to change the speed limit within the corporation limits of the City on Southway Street. The current speed limit in Perry Township is 55 mph and the County is proposing the 45 mph limit for uniformity which is based on a speed zone study that was performed on their behalf.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety is hereby authorized to change the speed limit within the corporation limits for the City of Massillon and post signs to that effect.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
