TITLE: AN ORDINANCE to accept the dedication of road right of way area located on the east side of 9th Street S.W., and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The City accepts the dedication of road right of way areas as shown on the attached map. At its November 19, 2014 meeting, the City Planning Commission approved said dedication and replat for the property of PSR Development; located on the east side of 9th St. S.W. The request includes the dedication of approximately 1 acre of property to be used as part of the current 9th Street SW roadway replacement project. The area is currently zoned I-1 Industrial.

Section 2:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 3:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
