# **EXHIBIT "A"**

# 505.01 HARBORING DOGS, CATS AND OTHER ANIMALS.

- (a) No person shall harbor cattle, sheep, geese, ducks, turkeys, chickens or other fowl within city corporation limits, with the exception of Agricultural Zoned areas or properties 5 acres or more.
- (b) No person being the owner of or having charge of any dog or cat whether wearing a registration tag or not, shall permit it to run at large upon any public place or upon the premises of another. No owner, keeper or harborer of any female dog or cat shall permit such dog or cat to go beyond the premises of such owner or keeper at any time such dog or cat is in heat, unless such dog or cat is properly in leash. The owner or keeper of every dog shall at all times keep such dog either confined upon the premises of the owner or keeper, or under reasonable control of some person.
- (c) The running at large of any such animal in or upon any of the places mentioned in this section is prima-facie evidence that it is running at large in violation of this section.
- (d) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. (Ord. 195-1985. Passed 12-2-85.)
