ORDINANCE NO. 106 – 2015

BY: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to enter into an agreement with Massillon Development Foundation to provide an economic development gap funding to assist the business commercial development and extension of Millennium Road, for the year ending December 31, 2015, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon carries out a variety of economic development programs designed to promote the creation and expansion of business and industry in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Massillon Development Foundation desires to extend Millennium Road for future development of commercial parcels in the City of Massillon; and

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon proposed to assist the Massillon Development Foundation with the commercial development and extension of Millennium Road by providing economic development gap funding, the purpose of which is to help with the cost of the extension project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Massillon Development Foundation by providing economic development gap funding in the total amount not to exceed Thirty Five Thousand Dollars (\$35,000.00) for the purpose of assisting the Massillon Development Foundation with the Millennium Road Extension Project.

Section 2:

In return for this economic development grant assistance, the Massillon Development Foundation shall provide the City with information regarding the number of jobs that future development of commercial parcels have provided as a result of the Millennium Road Extension Project.
