TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the State Route 93 Crack Sealing Project, PID 99433, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the State Route 93 Crack Sealing Project, PID 99433.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the State Route 93 Crack Sealing Project, PID 99433. The State has identified the need to perform pavement maintenance located within the Corporation Limits of the City of Massillon (see attached). There is no cost share by the City for the project is 100% ODOT funded.

Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
