TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the State Route 172 Resurfacing Project, PID 101268, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

## Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds that it is necessary to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) for the State Route 172 Resurfacing Project, PID 101268.

### Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the State Route 172 Resurfacing, PID 101268. The State has identified the need to resurface State Route 172 located within the Corporation Limits of the City of Massillon (see attached). There is a 20% cost share by the City for the project.

### Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

## Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community, and for the reason that it is necessary to sign the Preliminary Legislation with the Ohio Department of Transportation for the State Route 172 Resurfacing Project, PID 101268. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION I - Project Description			
WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:			
Resurfacing STA SR 172 from 3.95 to 6.84, STA SR 236 from 0.00 to 0.41, urban paving in the City of Massillon.			
NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by City of Massillon of Stark County, Ohio.			
SECTION II - Consent Statement (LPA)			
Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.			
SECTION III - Cooperation Statement			
The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:			
The LPA agrees to participate in the cost of construction within the city limits at twenty percent (20%) total cost.			
The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.			
The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.			
(Optional-if required) The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or repair curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with			

Disabilities Act.

### SECTION IV - Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The LPA agrees to acquire and/or make available to ODOT, in accordance with current State and Federal regulations, all necessary right-of-way required for the described Project. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees to be responsible for all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement and agrees that such accommodation, relocations and reimbursements shall comply with current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

### **SECTION V - Maintenance**

Upon completion of the described Project, and unless otherwise agreed, the LPA shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the described Project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, 23 USC 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for the maintenance of the described Project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.


The LPA agrees that if Federal Funds are used to pay the cost of any consultant contract, the LPA shall comply with 23 CFR 172 in the selection of its consultant and the administration of the consultant contract. Further the LPA agrees to incorporate ODOT's "Specifications for Consulting Services" as a contract document in all of its consultant contracts. The LPA agrees to require, as a scope of services clause, that all plans prepared by the consultant must conform to ODOT's current design standards and that the consultant shall be responsible for ongoing consultant involvement during the construction phase of the Project. The LPA agrees to include a completion schedule acceptable to ODOT and to assist ODOT in rating the consultant's performance through ODOT's Consultant Evaluation System.
