TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to accept the dedication of the sanitary sewer easement, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines that it is necessary for the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to accept the dedication of the sanitary sewer easement area as shown on the attached map. At its May 27, 2015 meeting, the City Planning Commission approved said easement for a portion of property owned by Financing VI Healthcare Property, LLC, which is The Laurels of Massillon. The existing sanitary sewer which runs on this property never had an easement associated with it.

Section 2:

The Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to accept the dedication of the sanitary sewer easement at a portion of property owned by Financing VI Healthcare Property, LLC, which is The Laurels of Massillon.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance.
