ORDINANCE NO. 210 – 2015

BY: FINANCE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE reducing the appropriations in the 1100 General Fund, the 1421 Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Fund, the 3105 State Patrol Transfer Fund, the 1209 Police Pension Fund and the 1210 Fire Pension Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The appropriations are hereby reduced in the 1100 General Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, as follows:

\$ 261,571.70 from an account entitled "9th St. SW Improvement Fund" - 1100.405.5.2394

Section 2:

The appropriations are hereby reduced in the 1421 Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, as follows:

\$1,050.965.97 from an account entitled "WWT Plant Upgrade Project" - 1421.610.5.2510

Section 3:

The appropriations are hereby reduced in the 3105 State Patrol Transfer Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, as follows:

\$ 11,112.23 from an account entitled "State Patrol Transfer Law Library" - 3105.930.5.2390
\$ 11,112.17 from an account entitled "State Patrol Refund to General" - 3105.930.5.2720

Section 4:

The appropriations are hereby reduced in the 1209 Police Pension Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, as follows:

\$ 37,296.65 from an account entitled "Police Pension"

Section 5:

The appropriations are hereby reduced in the 1210 Fire Pension Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2015, as follows:

\$ 98,706.63 from an account entitled "Fire Pension"

Section 5:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 6:

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that the appropriations need to be reduced because of an audit procedure. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
