#### Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, desires to amend Section 521 by renumbering 521.10(d) to (e) and enact a new Section 521.10(d) to state that no person shall smoke in or upon Duncan Plaza and Veterans Park.

# Section 2:

There be and is hereby enacted the renumbering of Section 521.10(d) to (e) and enact a new Section 521.10(d) of the Chapter 521 "HEALTH, SAFETY AND SANITATION" of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Massillon, Ohio. Said newly enacted Section shall read as follows:

<u>521.10(d)</u>: No person shall smoke in or upon Duncan Plaza or Veterans Park. Appropriate signage shall be posted by the Director of Public Service and Safety indicating such designation
