TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign the Consent Legislation with the Ohio Dept. of Transportation (ODOT), for the STA-US 30-0.00 Project, PID 87284, for the year ending December 31, 2016, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby finds it necessary for the Director of Public Service and Safety of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to sign the Consent Legislation with ODOT for the STA-US 30-0.00 Project, PID 87284.

Section 2:

Whereas the State has identified the need for the described project located within the Corporation Limits of the City of Massillon, Ohio, (see attached map). Per Section 5521.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of Transportation is required to request and receive legislation from municipalities, prior to making any necessary repairs to State Highways within the corporate limits.

Section 3:

There is no cost share by City for the project as it is 100% ODOT funded. The Project is currently scheduled for 2017.

Section 5:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the reason for the emergency being that said amendment is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
