ORDINANCE NO. 1 – 2017

BY: RULES, COURTS AND CIVIL SERVICE COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE amending Sections 2 and 4 of Ordinance No. 26 – 2016, appointing the City Records Custodian, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

As part of the annual audit of the City by the State Auditor, the State Auditor previously recommended that the City designate a person as a Records Custodian, and that person is no longer employed by the City of Massillon, Ohio.

Section 2:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary to accept the appointment of Joseph G. Alessandro Sr. the City Records Custodian as recommended by the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary to have a City Records Custodian appointed to keep in compliance with the Ohio Revised Code 149.43, which the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, recommended Joseph G. Alessandro Sr. for the appointment. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Section 1:

There be and hereby is appropriated from the unappropriated balance of the 1206 Municipal Motor Vehicle License Fund, for the year ending December 31, 2017, the following:

Section 2:

The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Section 3:

This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the efficient operation of the various departments of the City of Massillon and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the community. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
