ORDINANCE NO. 47 – 2017

BY: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to enter into an agreement with Friends and Family Credit Union to provide an economic development "inducement grant" to assist the business in renovation expenses at 46 Federal Avenue N.W., and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon carries out a variety of economic development programs designed to promote the creation and expansion of business and industry in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Friends and Family Credit Union's desire to renovate the building located at 46 Federal Avenue N.W., and

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon proposes to assist the Friends and Family Credit Union with renovation expenses of the business by providing an economic development "inducement grant", the purpose of which is to help offset the company's costs with the renovations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Friends and Family Credit Union by providing an economic development "inducement grant", in a total amount not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for the purpose of assisting the business renovation at 46 Federal Avenue N.W.

Section 2:

In return for this economic development grant assistance, the Friends and Family Credit Union shall provide the City with information regarding the number of jobs that it has provided as a result of the renovation to the business.

Section 3:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 4:

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason that it is necessary to improve the economic climate of the community through the renovation of the business. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to accept a grant from the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District for revitalization of the Tuscarawas River in and around downtown Massillon, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to accept a grant from the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District for the revitalization of the Tuscarawas River. The Council has also determined it necessary for the Mayor to enter into a consulting contract with Stantec Consulting Services for this project.

Section 2:

The Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to accept a grant in the amount of Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$22,500.00) from the Muskingum Watershed Conservancy District for the revitalization of the Tuscarawas River in and around downtown Massillon, Ohio. The Mayor is further authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Stantec Consulting for this project. The total cost of the project is in the amount of Twenty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$28,500.00). The balance of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) is to be paid by the City of Massillon.
