TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Mayor of the City of Massillon, Ohio, to enter into an agreement with Tremont Coffee to provide an economic development "inducement grant" to assist the business with start-up and build out costs at 28 Erie St. N., Massillon, Ohio, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon carries out a variety of economic development programs designed to promote the creation and expansion of business and industry in the community; and

WHEREAS, Tremont Coffee plans to renovate the building located at 28 Erie St. N., and

WHEREAS, the City of Massillon proposes to assist Tremont Coffee with start-up and build out costs by providing an economic development "inducement grant", the purpose of which is to help offset the company's costs with start-up and build out costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Tremont Coffee by providing an economic development "inducement grant", in a total amount not to exceed Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) for the purpose of assisting the business with start-up and build out costs at 28 Erie St. N., Massillon, Ohio.

Section 2:

In return for this economic development grant assistance, Tremont Coffee shall provide the City with information regarding the number of jobs that it has provided as a result of starting this business.
