ORDINANCE NO. 48 – 2020

BY: PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Massillon, Ohio, and the Manager of The Legends of Massillon Golf Course to enter into an agreement with Westin and Associates to accept a donation to install barriers on golf carts at The Legends of Massillon Golf Course, and declaring an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MASSILLON, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1:

The Council of the City of Massillon, Ohio, hereby determines it to be necessary in the public health, safety and welfare to authorize the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Massillon, Ohio, and the Manager of The Legends of Massillon Golf Course to enter into an agreement with Westin and Associates to accept a donation to install barriers on golf carts at The Legends of Massillon Golf Course.

Section 2:

The Director of the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Massillon, Ohio, and the Manager of The Legends of Massillon Golf Course are hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Westin and Associates to accept a donation to install barriers on golf carts at The Legends of Massillon Golf Course. Said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". Westin and Associates has agreed to install one hundred (100) barriers on golf carts to allow no contact between the driver and passenger while golfing and riding together at the golf course at no cost to the City. The barriers will be in compliance with CDC and PGA guidelines to control the spread of COVID-19. The retail cost of the barriers would normally be Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000.00). As a result of their generosity for this donation, the City of Massillon Parks and Recreation Board is donating to Westin and Associates, three (3), seven (7) day golf passes to The Legends of Massillon Golf Course for the 2020 golf season.

Section 3:

This agreement was voted on by the City of Massillon Parks and Recreation Board and was approved by a 3 – 1 vote.

Section 4:

The Clerk of Council is authorized to correct any typographical errors discovered herein during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. The Clerk of Council is further authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department and the Council President to correct any ministerial or de minimis errors that do not substantially alter the intended results or numerical total sums of this ordinance, during or after the pendency or passage of this ordinance. Corrected copies are to be sent to all official recipients.

Section 5:

That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the community and for the additional reason to allow the placement of the barriers for the golf carts to be done as soon as possible. Provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the elected members to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Westin & Associates has agreed to donate materials and services to the City of Massillon Parks and Recreation board.
