#### Street Dedication

Location: Massillon Development Foundation, Inc., Business Park (formerly the Rank Farm), the specific request being to dedicate the following additional street right-of-way:

- 1) An additional 10 feet of right-of-way on the west side of Erie Street South from Warmington Road, S.W., southerly a distance of 1,438.14 feet to the south property line of Part of Out Lot 587.
- 2) The extension of Navarre Road on the west side of Erie Street South, dedicating a 46 foot wide right-of-way at the southern end of Part of Out Lot 587 from Erie Street South, westerly a distance of 720 feet. (A four foot wide strip of land at the south property line of Out Lot 587 will remain undedicated at this time.)


